TUNNELS TOUR VISITOR DECLARATION



The Fremantle Prison tunnels tour is a soft adventure experience that is not without an element of risk. The two and half-hour tour includes the negotiation of stairs, ladders, uneven surfaces, narrow passageways and paddling small watercraft. Whilst you will be provided with equipment for your safety and comfort, the experience involves physical exertion and requires a reasonable level of fitness, flexibility and coordination.

There are a number of conditions that may have an effect on your ability to participate safely in the tour such as a fear of enclosed spaces; claustrophobia; fear of heights; vertigo; angina or any other heart condition; high blood pressure; visual impairment (other than wearing glasses or contact lenses); severe or uncontrolled asthma; diabetes or epilepsy; a limb or back injury, or any other physical impairment or medical condition that affects your ability to walk, climb ladders, access confined spaces, board and control small paddle craft. If you are an expectant mother or are recovering from a medical procedure, you are advised not to participate on this tour.

If you have any of these conditions, or any other condition not listed above that you reasonably suspect may put your safety and health at risk and that of other visitors and employees of Fremantle Prison on your tour, you should consider whether or not you participate on this tour. *If you are unsure, please seek clarification from your Tour Leader.* As items of personal property are not permitted on the tunnels tour, you will need to make arrangements with your Tour Leader to carry any essential medication with you (for example, asthma inhalers).

A condition of entry to the underground sections of the tour is that you are able to be fitted with the safety equipment provided by Fremantle Prison.

VISITOR DECLARATION

I declare that:

- 1. I am over 12 years of age.
- 2. I do not believe that I have a health, physical or psychological condition that will put my own safety and health at risk or that of any other participant on the tunnels tour.
- 3. I am willing to take a breath test and understand that I will not be permitted to participate in the tunnels tour if my Blood Alcohol Concentration reading is 0.05% or more.
- 4. I am not under the influence of any form of drugs.
- 5. I will not take any items of personal property on the tour without the express permission of my Tour Leader.
- 6. I will not damage, deface or remove any element or part of Fremantle Prison, the tunnels or any of the equipment issued to me.
- 7. I will obey and follow the instructions of my Tour Leader at all times and will respect and not interfere with the enjoyment of the tunnels tour by other visitors, and that I will be removed from the tour without refund if I do not comply with these or any of the above requirements.

I understand and warrant that:

- 8. I have entered and remain on the premises and property of Fremantle Prison at my own risk.
- 9. Fremantle Prison will not be responsible for any loss, damage or injury arising from any pre-existing medical condition, physical or psychological. If I disobey any safety instructions given to me by Fremantle Prison and as a consequence I suffer loss, damage or injury, I will not hold Fremantle Prison liable.
- 10. I hereby release and discharge Fremantle Prison, the Government of Western Australian and its servants and agents to the extent permitted by law from all claims which I now or at any time have in connection with my participation in a Fremantle Prison tunnels tour or other circumstances mentioned in this declaration. I agree that this includes any claims that I could or might have if it were not for this declaration.
- 11. I authorise Fremantle Prison to use and reproduce any photography taken of me for any purpose without further compensation to me, and that any photograph(s) provided to me or purchased by me from Fremantle Prison remain copyright to Fremantle Prison and will not be used by me for any commercial purpose without the written permission of Fremantle Prison.
- 12. The decision to participate in the Fremantle Prison tunnels tour is my own.
